**KINGSWOOD NURSERIES AND ADJACENT LAND.**

At the last meeting of the Parish Council, local resident Peter Foster was in attendance and pleaded with the Members of the Parish Council to lift our objection to the Planning Appeal for Kingswood Nurseries, and instead be in support of the 'Change of Use' for residential purposes.

After much discussion it was agreed by the Members to continue to uphold their objection to the Planning application, for all the following reasons, Loss of Green Belt, not setting a precedent for other applications / changes of use, and that the possible application is not in the interest of the whole village. It was noted that the land adjacent to the Kingswood Nurseries was already subject to a Court Injunction which restricts various usage other than for agricultural purposes and that land in that area not be singularly owned by the Parish Council.
